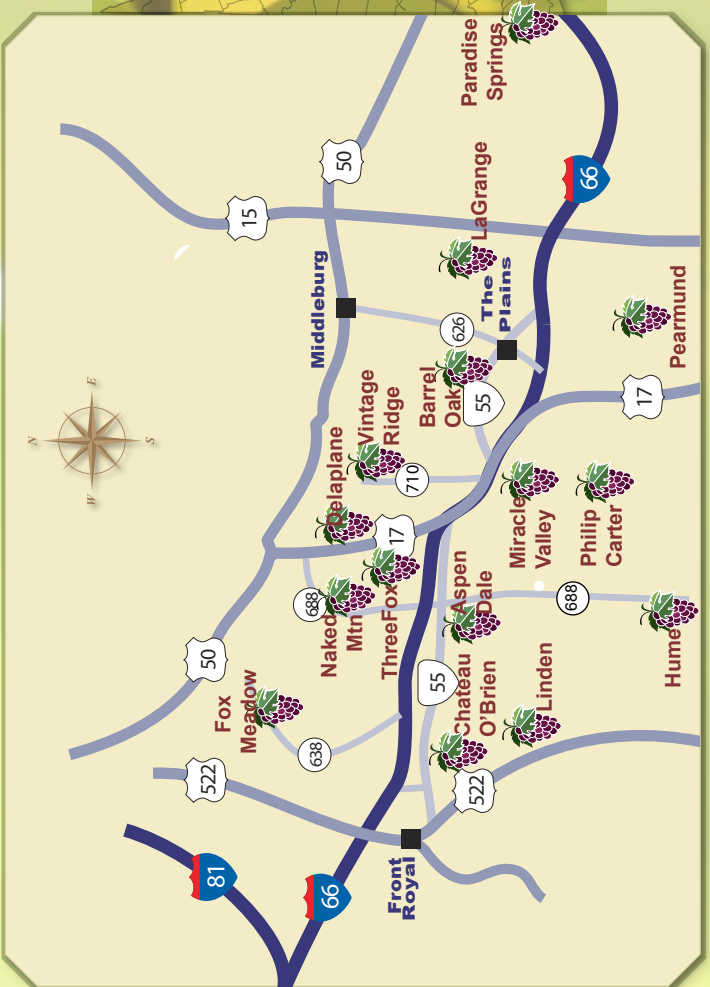
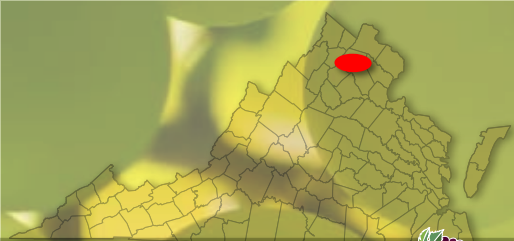

Take I-66 West to Exit 18 (Markham). Make a left at end of exit ramp and continue across State Road 55. At the stop sign make a left and then just past the winery sign make a right onto Rail Stop Road.

Delaplane Cellars is nestled on Lost Mountain on Route 17, halfway between Delaplane and Paris, with a panoramic view

overlooking the historic Crooked Run Valley.

All of the wines are carefully handcrafted using only 100% Virginia-grown European wine grape varieties including Chardonnay, Viognier, Syrah, Tannat and the four principle red Bordeaux varietals: Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. **OPEN: TFFSSM** 

From I-66 take exit 23 to Route 17 North approximately 4 miles to winery exit on the right. From Route 50 take Route 17 South approximately 4 miles to winery entrance on the left.

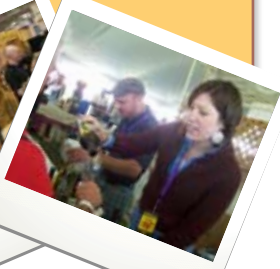

Situated at an elevation of 1700 feet above sea level, Fox Meadows Vineyards allows visitors to actually “look down on the tops of mountains” and see as many as seven mountain ranges.

Wine varietals at Fox Meadow include Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Syrah and “Freezeland Red”, a unique blend of the Portuguese varietals, Tinta Cao and Touriga and Spanish Tempranillo.

Whether your taste is for dry wines like Cabernet Franc or Syrah or whimsical fruity wines like Pinot Grigio, Fox Meadow has something for you.

OPEN: MTWTFSS - Jan-Feb TFSSM 

Take I-66 West to Linden exit (Rt 13). Rt. 55 East 1.3 miles to Rt 638 (Freezeland Road). Turn left and go 3.1 miles to vineyard.

Linden Vineyards is situated high on the Virginia Blue Ridge, 65 miles west of Washington, D.C.

This winery is considered to be one of the most progressive wineries in the country. In-depth cellar tastings that include older vintages and limited releases are offered on weekends where visitors can learn the differences in vineyard sites, vintages, and winemaking styles.

Current offerings include Avenius Red, Boisseau Red, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Claret, Avenius Sauvignon Blanc, Seyval, Vidal Riesling, Chardonnay, Late Harvest Petit Manseng and Late Harvest Vidal.

OPEN: WTFSS - Dec-Mar SS 

From Washington take I-66 to Exit 18, Markham. West on Route 55 for 4.2 miles to the village of Linden. Left on Route 638 for 2 miles.

Pearmund Cellars is located in the beautiful foothills of eastern Fauquier County, conveniently close to Northern Virginia and Washington, DC.

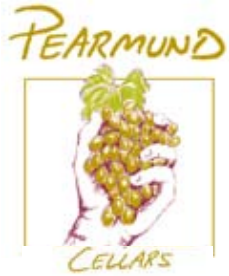

There are few places that can boast the depth of wine history that Philip Carter Winery, located in Hume Virginia, reflects. The Carter family carries a two hundred and fifty year legacy as maker of the first recognized fine wine in America.

It was Charles Carter, who, in 1762, sent the London Society for the Encouragement of the Arts a dozen bottles of his Virginia wine.

The society awarded Carter a gold medal as the first person to make a “spirited attempt towards the accomplishment of their views, respecting wine in America.”

OPEN: MTWTFSS 

Take I-66 west to Exit 18 (Markham). Take a left at end of exit ramp. Cross State Road 55, then take right at the stop sign. Continue on 688 for 3.6 miles, and take a left on Stillhouse Road. Entrance is on the right.

Three Fox Vineyards, on 50 acres of rolling countryside in the middle of Virginia’s hunt country, brings a little La Dolce Vita to Virginia!

Sample unique Italian varieties such as Sangiovese, Nebbiolo, and Pinot Grigio as well as Chardonnay, Viognier, Vidal, Merlot, Cab Franc, and Chambourcin (done as a port alternative).

Bring a picnic and relax in a setting reminiscent of Tuscany - outside on the patios (with “wine mobile” service) or on one of many other scenic spots on the property.

OPEN: TFSSM 

Take I-66 west to Delaplane (exit 23), then Rt. 17 north for about 1 mile. Cross the railroad tracks and turn left onto Three Fox Lane.
