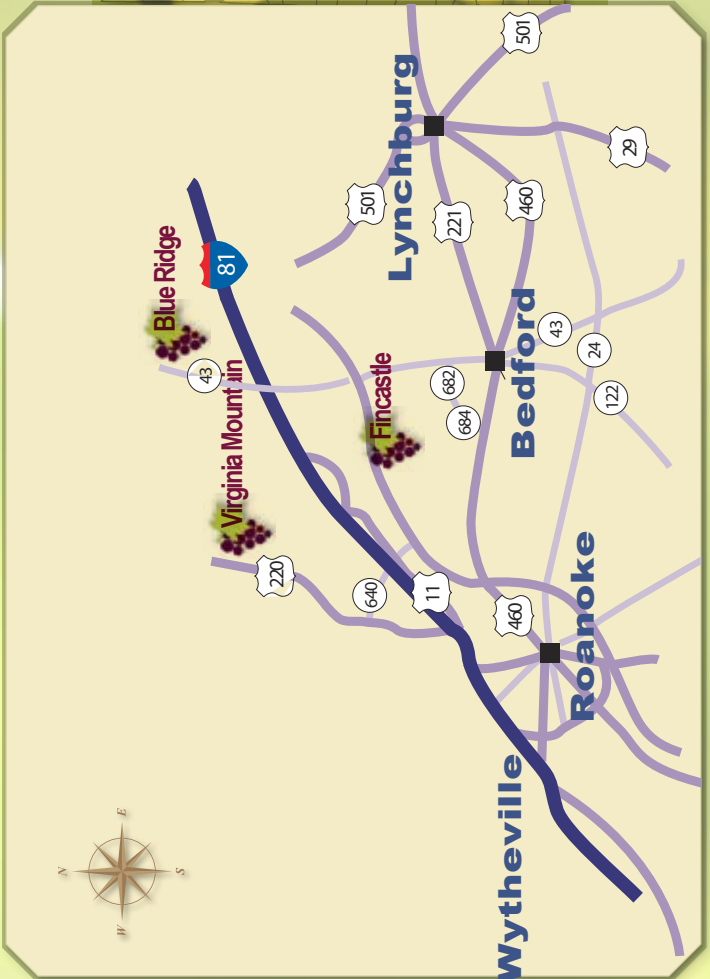
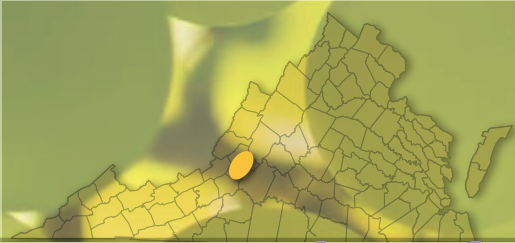


Botetourt Virginia

Just West of I-81 in Botetourt County



Wine paired with a panoramic view is the mantra of Blue Ridge Vineyards in Southwest Virginia. The planting of Riesling, Pinot Noir, and Gewurztraminer marked this winery's beginning in 1985. At 1200 feet above sea level, the western facing slope of the Blue Ridge proved to be the perfect place for the first vinifera plantings in southwest Virginia. The vineyard quickly expanded in all directions with the addition of more Riesling, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Franc, Gewurztraminer, and Traminette.



I-81 exit 162. Take Rt. 11 to Rt. 43. Turn right toward Eagle Rock. Left on Rt 612.

Nestled in the Great Valley of Virginia's Blue Ridge Mountains, Fincastle Vineyard & Winery produces wines using traditional Bordeaux small scale techniques. From the vines of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and

Chardonnay come wines pressed gently and aged in oak.

From I-81 Take Exit 156 Turn right onto VA-640/Brughs Mill Road. Continue to follow VA-640. 0.8 miles. Turn right on US Route 11 Go .25 Miles. Turn left onto VA-640/Nace Road. 1.7 miles Turn left onto Maple ridge Lane.

At Virginia Mountain Vineyards you can forget about the present and enjoy the picturesque mountain views visible on top of Zion Hill. Surrounded by the Blue Ridge Mountains to the east and the Alleghany Mountains to the west, the winery is located fourteen miles north of Roanoke on Interstate

81, just off route 220 outside the center of Historic Fincastle.

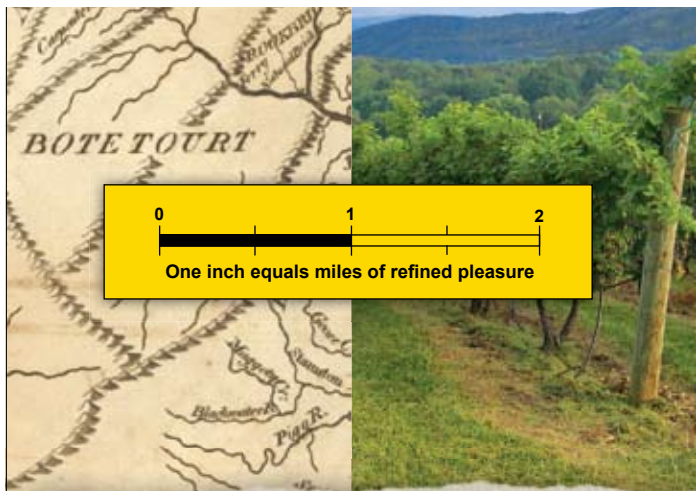
Virginia Mountain Vineyards was established as a vineyard in the spring of 1998 with the planting of two grape varieties (Chardonnay and Cabernet Franc) totaling 3325 vines. The operation has since grown to include an additional three grape varieties (Merlot, Traminette, and Petit Verdot) bringing the vine total to 5625 over a 9.5 acre plot.

I-81 exit 150B to Rt. 220 North. Go approx. 8 miles. Turn left on Rt. 655. Winery is 4.2 miles on right.
