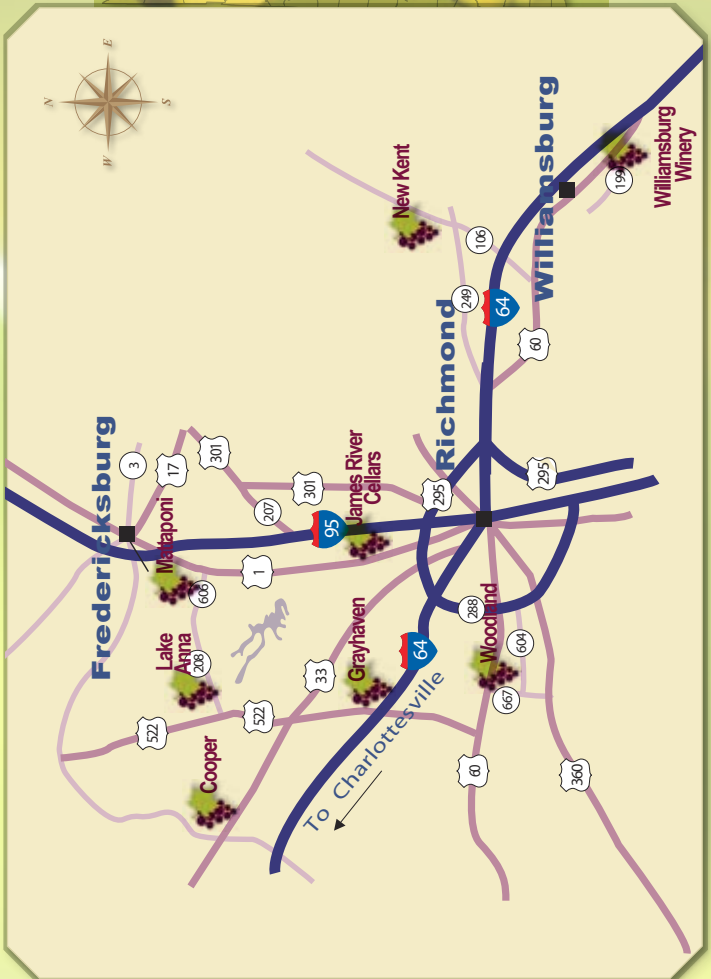
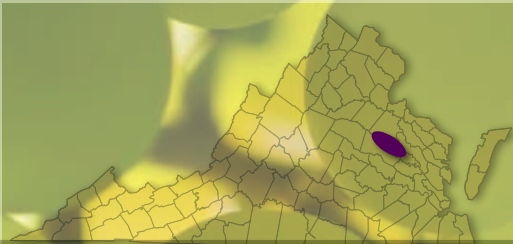
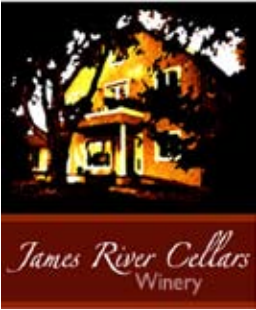


Toward Richmond Virginia

Along I-95 and I-64 in Richmond Vacinity



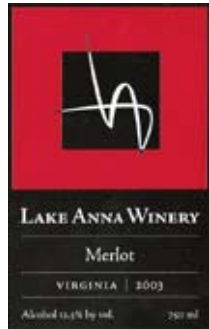


A Richmond Area Winery! James River Cellars is located just 10 miles North of Richmond or just 10 miles South of Kings Dominion, right off I-95. This family owned winery offers over 15 varieties of award winning wines from Virginia Grown Grapes. Chardonnay, Gewurztraminer, Vidal Blanc, Chardonel, Petit Verdo, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Chambourcin and several distinctive blends.

From I-95 take exit 86 (Atlee/Elmont) West to Rt. 1 North. Winery is 1 mile on right.

Centrally located between Fredericksburg, Culpeper, Charlottesville and Richmond, Lake Anna Winery can be easily reached from almost any area of Virginia. Vines here date back to 1983 and are some of the oldest in Virginia. Wine varietals include Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Seyval Blanc, Chardonnay, Gewurtztraminer, Vidal Blanc and several exquisite blends. The destination, at Lake Anna, is surrounded by both natural beauty and historic significance.



From Fredericksburg take Rt. 1 bypass south to Four Mile Fork. Turn right on Rt. 208/Courthouse Rd. Turn left at Spotsylvania Courthouse; right at Snell and left at Post Oak. Go 7 miles to Winery.

Mattaponi is a small family-owned winery in the heart of Spotsylvania County. With a 20 passion for making wonderful wines, grape vines now grow along side Christmas trees and the old log cabin was transformed into a cozy tasting room. Inaugural wines include Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Blanc, Riesling and Muscadine wines as well as peach, blueberry, blackberry and strawberry wines.



From I-95, take Exit 118 Thornburg, Right at Ramp, Cross over Rt. 1, Go approximately 4.5 miles, Mattaponi Winery is on your left.

New Kent Winery, centrally located between Colonial Williamsburg and Richmond, is one of the newest and largest wineries in Virginia. The winery is constructed with reclaimed

materials including 40-foot heart pine trusses and pre-Civil War brick. A variety of vines were planted in 2001, including Chardonnay, Vidal Blanc, Cabernet Franc and Norton - the grape native to Virginia. The inaugural flight of wines includes: Chardonnay, Vidal Blanc, White Norton, Merlot and Meritage.

From I-95 at Richmond take exit 75 to merge onto I-64 (East) toward Williamsburg/Norfolk. Take exit 211 for VA-106 toward Talleyville/Prince George. Turn left at Emmaus Church Rd/VA-106. Continue on Old Church Rd.

The Williamsburg Winery is Virginia's largest winery with an annual production of some 60,000 cases. The winery was established

in 1985, and the first wine produced, Governor's White, won a Gold Medal within two weeks. Today, Governor's White is the most popular wine made at the winery. 50+ acres of vineyards surround the winery offering a beautiful backdrop to the Old World-style village and the new Wedmore Place Hotel overlooking the James River and the vineyards.

From I-64 take exit 234 to Rt 199 East. On Rt 199 turn right after the Jamestown Road intersection onto Brookwood Drive then left onto Lake Powell Road. Winery is one mile on left.

Woodland Vineyard, located in Midlothian, qualifies as the state's smallest farm winery. The vineyard is situated on a small 1/2 acre plot (aka "the yard") on the family property, which also houses a small winery,

several picnic tables and an outdoor patio for guests. The first vines at Woodland Vineyard were planted in 1997. The quality of the wines made here were so good that what began as a hobby quickly turned into a full-scale business, and in December of 2004, Woodland Vineyard officially opened its tasting room doors.

From Richmond take Powhite Parkway South until it ends. Turn Left onto Charter Colony Parkway and then right at the intersection with Genito Road.

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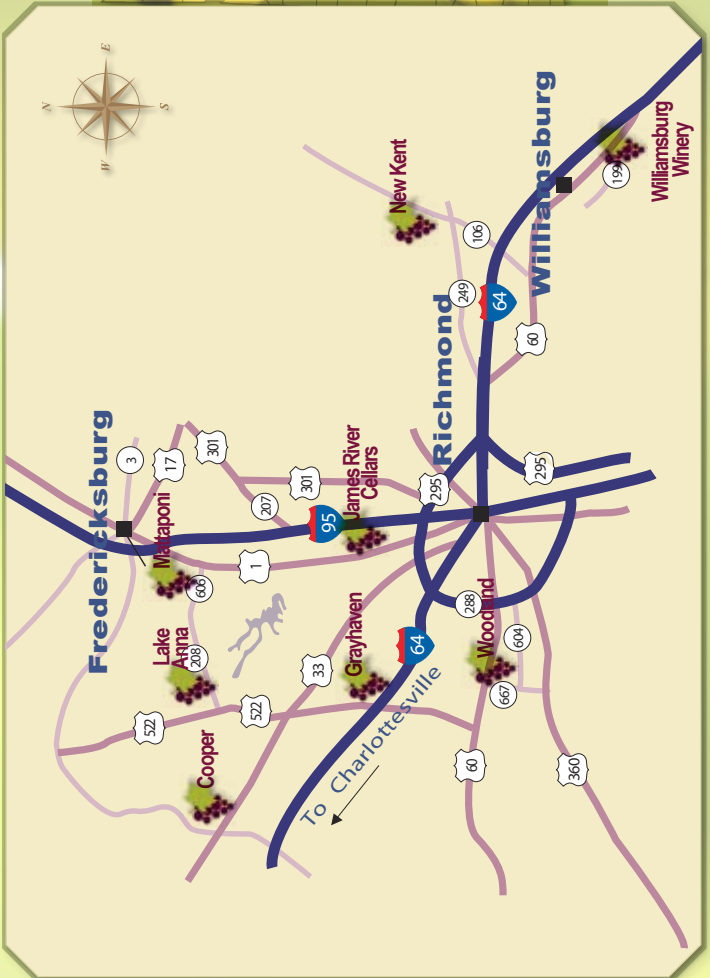
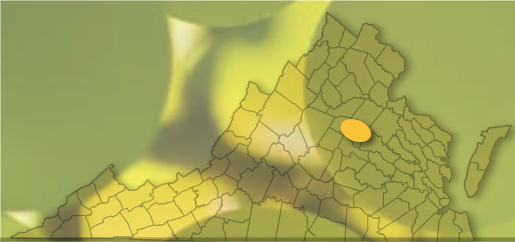

- Ice Vidal and Norton Ice. This unique tasting room is located inside the winery itself.

Grayhaven is a boutique winery located in the beautiful rolling hills of central Virginia. The vineyard was planted in 1978. In the mid 90's, the first "crush" marked the launch of Grayhaven Winery, specializing in small batch production of fine wines. Many varieties of Vinifera, French Hybrid and American grapes are used by Grayhaven's winemakers to

produce both special blends and 100% varietals, including the rarely found Pinotage, Touriga, Cayuga White and Golden Muscat varietals.

Take I-64 to exit 159. South on Rt. 522; right on Rt. 250; right on Rt. 700; right on Rt. 619; right on Shepherd Spring Rd.; left on Fox Chase Run; right on East Gray Fox
