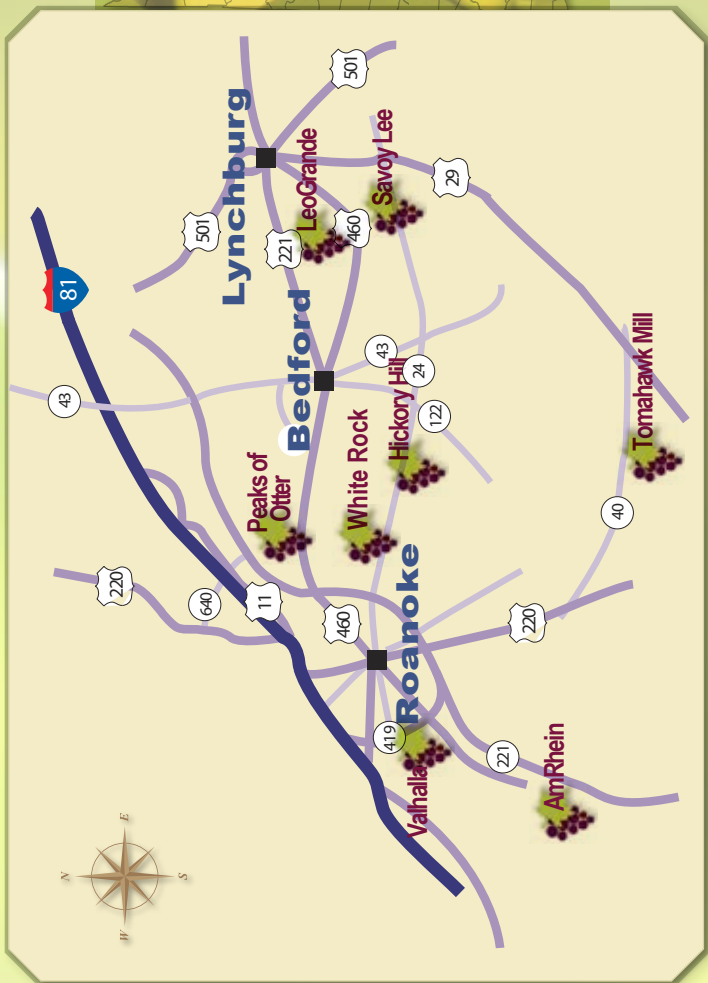
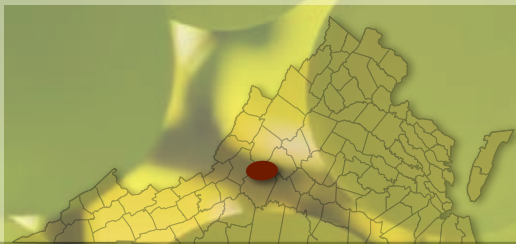


Roanoke-Bedford Virginia

Just east of I-81 near Roanoke & Bedford





AmRhein Wine Cellars hugs the side of the rolling Blue Ridge Mountains in the heart of Southwest Virginia.

The name AmRhein means “on the Rhein (Rhine) river” which is located in Germany. The winery specializes in unique Virginia-style wines with a German influence. The AmRhein wine list includes a distinctive portfolio of 21 wines with several varieties seldom found in Virginia - Petit Manseng, Pinot Grigio, Traminette, Anglianico, Vidal Blanc Ice Wine and the AmRhein signature wine - Petit Verdot.

From Blue Ridge Parkway (Adney Gap) at mile marker #136 exit to Rt. 221 South. Travel .7 mile and take a right on Rt. 644. Travel 1.2 miles; when the road forks take a right onto Patterson Drive.

Hickory Hill Vineyards is nestled in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains on the east side of Smith Mountain Lake. Gorgeous fields that were once a cattle ranch homestead today produce world-class wines, including Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon and Vidal Blanc. In addition to these classic style wines, the winery produces a Smith Mountain Lake Series, which includes the blends - Mist, Country Red, Sunset and Redbud.

From Lynchburg take 460 West to Bedford. Take the Route 122 exit towards Smith Mountain Lake. Turn left on 655 just South of Moneta. Go 2 miles on Route 655 and turn right on Route 654. The vineyard is .7 mile on your left.

LeoGrande Vineyard and Winery is located in Goode, in the heart of Bedford County. Drop by and visit our tasting room and veranda which offers a spectacular view of the Peaks of Otter and out-of-this-world sunsets over the Blue Ridge Mountain. Wines include many Italian varieties. Enjoy the 400 acre farm with its Black Angus, horses, goats, chickens & pot-bellied pigs. Call for details, events and hours.

From Lynchburg follow Route 221 south. Turn left on 668. Follow signs.

Even before the founding of Bedford County ancestors of this century farm were tilling the land, planting orchards, groves and vineyards and serving the public with fruits, produce, and spirits. It was only a natural outgrowth of this legacy that this fifth generation farm develop a winery in 1995. "Fruit of the Farm" wines are made from a wide variety of fruits apples, grapes, blackberries, blueberries, peaches, chili peppers, cherries, elderberries, and much more all grown here on the farm located in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains at the foot of the Peaks of Otter.

From the Blue Ridge Parkway at milepost 86, take 43 South for 4 miles, turn right on 682 for 3 miles, turn right on 680 for 1 mile and left at the entrance sign.

Within close driving range of Smith Mountain Lake, the Blue Ridge Mountains, historic Appomattox, and the cities of Bedford, Roanoke and Lynchburg, Savoy-Lee Winery is the perfect destination for a jaunt through the gorgeous rolling hills of the Virginia countryside. Savoy-Lee Winery grows both red and white European and French-American hybrid grapevines. They include Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Sangiovese, Chardonnay, and Sauvignon Blanc.

From Bedford take Route 43 South. Turn left on Route 626, Smith Mountain Lake Parkway. The road name changes to Johnson Mountain Road. After passing the Route 626/628 intersection, the winery is about 2 miles on the right side of the road.

The history of Tomahawk Mill takes you back in time to Confederate veteran James Anderson, who constructed a water-powered grist mill on Tomahawk Creek and began grinding for local farmers in 1888. The mill continued operation until 1988, when it was closed to plant a vineyard, starting with Chardonnay and Concord varieties. Pinot Noir, Johannesburg Riesling, and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes followed, and the first Chardonnay vintage was produced in 1990.

From Business Rt. 29 in Chatham: west on Rt. 57 for 4.5 miles; right on Rt. 799 for 3.4 miles; left on Rt. 649 for 3 miles to winery on left.

Valhalla Vineyards has been growing grapes and producing award winning estate wines from a 2000' mountaintop overlooking Roanoke since 1998. This 21 acre vineyard produces world class Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Merlot, Chardonnay, Cab Franc and more. The granite soils and unique climate (similar to Rhone Valley of France) afford the premiere terrior on the East Coast.

FROM I-81 Exit onto I-581 continue on 581 through downtown Roanoke, and exit right onto Franklin Road. Continue to the intersection of Brambleton Ave (8th traffic light) and turn left. At third stoplight, turn right onto Roselawn. Continue 2.3 miles and turn left onto Mt. Chestnut Rd. Valhalla is 0.9 miles on left.

White Rock Vineyards is a family owned farm winery located in the Goodview area of Bedford County, convenient to Smith Mountain Lake and the Blue Ridge Parkway. The first block of vines was planted here in 2000. Additional blocks have been added each year to make up 5 vinifera varieties - Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Pinot Gris and 2 hybrids - Chardonell and Traminette. White Rock guests enjoy distinctive wines and spectacular views from the veranda.

From Bedford take Route 122 South, right on Route 757 (Joppa Mill Road), right on Route 24, left on Route 653 (Mill Iron Road), left on Route 756 (Bruno Drive) to 2117 on left.

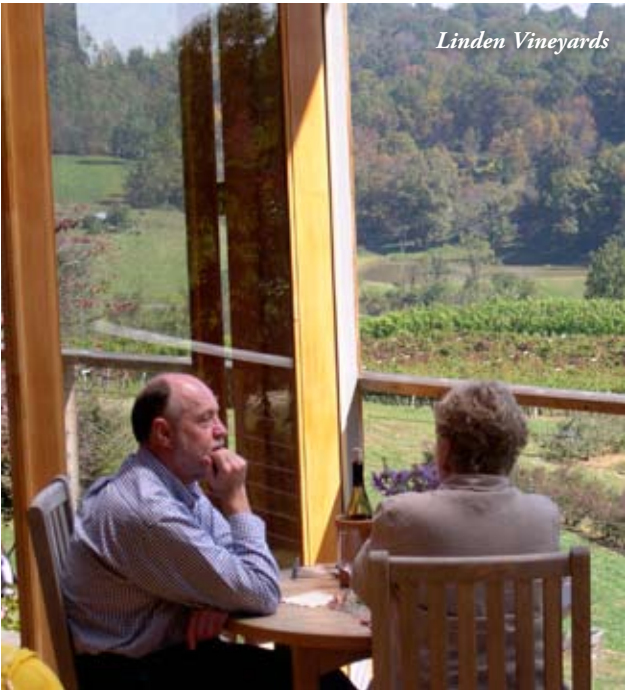

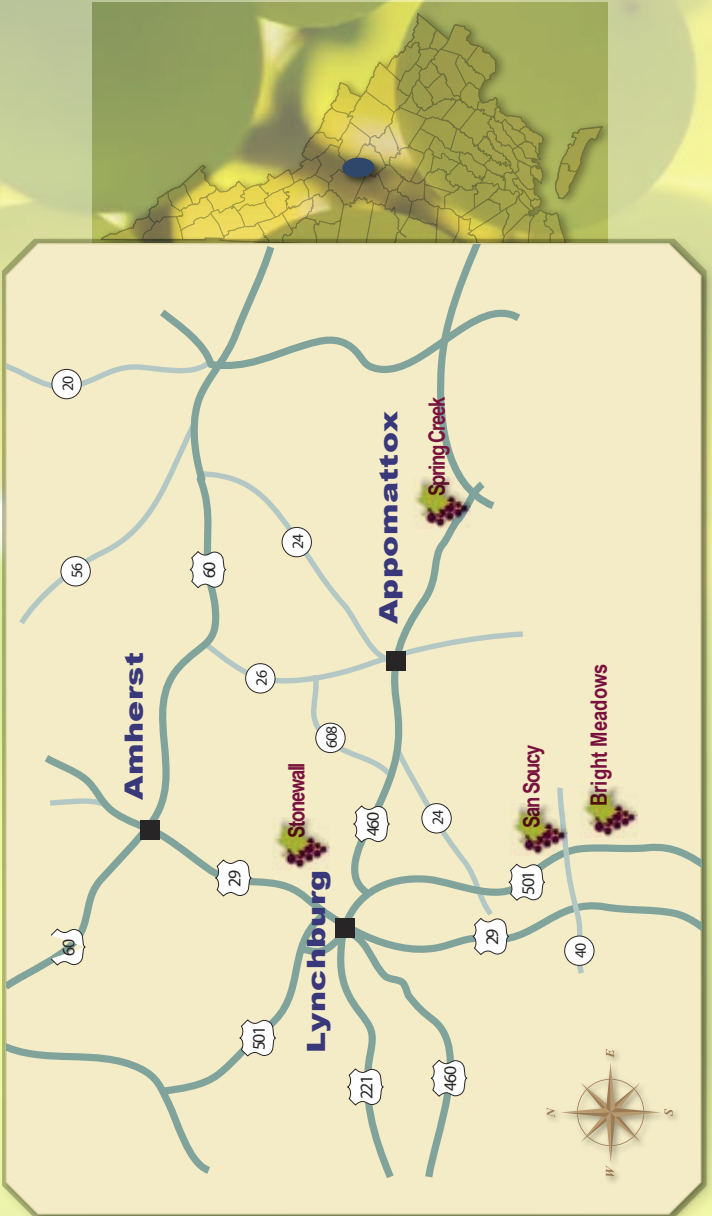

Bright Meadows Farm is a 50 acre estate nestled among the rolling hills of historic Halifax County on the site of a 19th century tobacco plantation. The unique

ambience of this winery, housed in a beautifully restored 115 year old barn, beckons with country wines and true southern hospitality. Varietals include our own Bright Meadows colonial style Blackberry Wine and other wines from American Vines.

From Lynchburg US 501 South, left on Rt. 645 (Acorn Road, which becomes Nathalie Road). 3.5 miles to Winery.

Sans Soucy is a small family-owned farm winery located in the historic tobacco country in Brookneal

just minutes away from Red Hill (Patrick Henry's last home and resting place) and within a 30 minute drive of historic Appomattox and the cities of Lynchburg and South Boston. Sans Soucy specializes in growing Traminette, Viognier, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, and Tempranillo varietals of grapes for the production of fine boutique wines.

From Lynchburg Take 501 south to Brookneal, go straight thru traffic light. Take first right after bridge Dog Creek Road, 2nd left on Mt Calvary Rd, 2nd house on left.

Spring Creek Wine Cellar is located in Virginia's heartland, south of the village of Pamplin. Located on the edge of three counties, the area is surrounded by national historic landmarks and outdoor recreation sites. Spring Creek is dedicated to making hand-crafted, high quality, dry wines. Fourteen grape varieties are grown in the vineyard and harvested at the peak of flavor development. The uniqueness of a single-vineyard grape source assures that regional flavors and aromas are captured in the wines.

Take Route 460 to Pamplin City. Take Rt. 47 South (Thomas Jefferson Highway) approximately 2.5 miles and turn left onto Rt. 663 (Baker Mountain Road). The winery entrance is one half mile on the left.

Nestled in the rolling hills of historic Appomattox, Stonewall Vineyards features a modern winery surrounded by history. The proximity of Stonewall to the Appomattox National Historic Park is valuable as approximately 350,000 people tour the park each year. One hour from Roanoke, two hours from Richmond and only three hours to Washington, Stonewall Vineyards is ideally located near the geographic center of Virginia.

From Lynchburg drive 12 miles east on Route 460. At the Concord light, go north 5 miles on Route 608, left 100 yards on Route 721. Stonewall is on your left.
