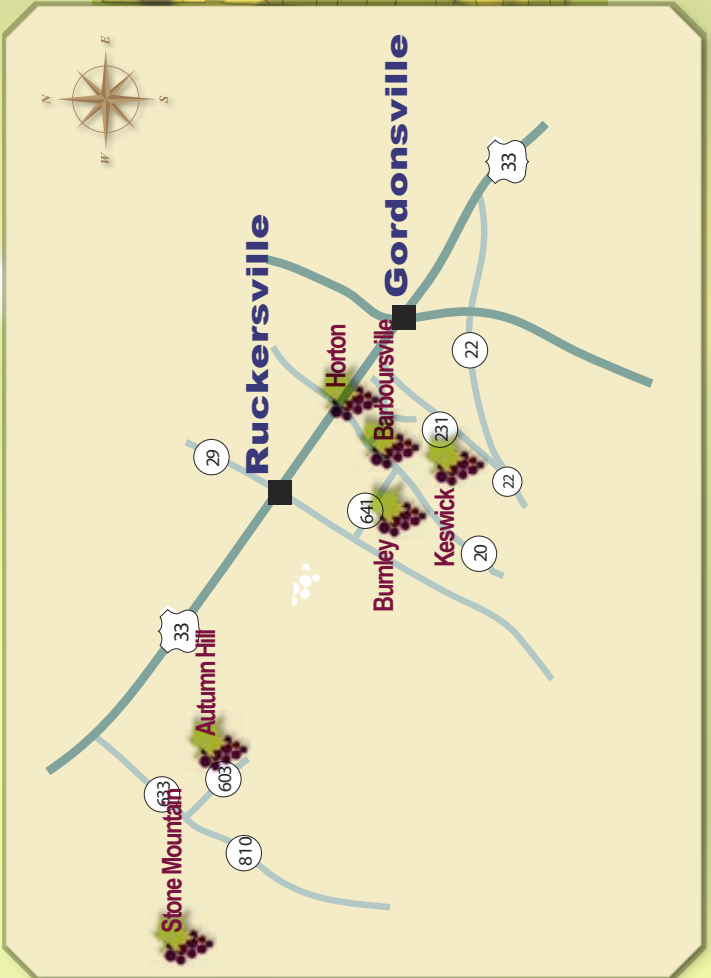
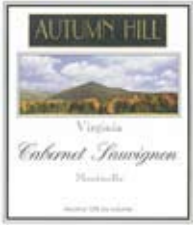


Ruckersville Virginia

From Route 29 Along Rte 33 & 22 North of Charlottesville





Autumn Hill Vineyards is home to some of the oldest Chardonnay and Cabernet Sauvignon vines in Virginia, planted in 1979. Today the estate includes 13 acres of Chardonnay, Viognier, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Malbec, and a new Nebbiolo area. The first vintage was produced in 1986, with a focus on full bodied, dry wines.

Located 15 miles North of Charlottesville. Take Rt. 29 to Rt. 33 west at Ruckersville, 2 miles to Quinque. Left at Rt. 633 (Amicus Rd.) for 6.5 miles to end at Rt. 603 (Bingham Mtn. Rd.), left for 1 mile to winery on left.

BARBOURSVILLE *Vineyards*

Barboursville Vineyards, home of Octagon VII 2004 (Winner of the 2006 Monticello Cup and Gold Medal at the International Critics Challenge), is Virginia's most awarded winery. Grown on the westerly slope of the Southwest Mountains in Orange County, between James Madison's Montpelier and Thomas Jefferson's Monticello, Barboursville wines are highly regarded in the wine press and in international wine competitions.

In Barboursville at the intersection of Rt. 33 and Rt. 20 take 20 South; then take the first left on Rt. 678 (for 1/2 mile); right on Rt. 777; first driveway on right.

Burnley Vineyards is one of the oldest Vineyards in the Monticello Viticultural Area. This family winery produces 5,000 cases a year from vinifera and French hybrid grapes. 30 acres of vineyards are planted in Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Orange Muscat, Muscat Blanc, Chambourcin, Vidal and even a little of the elusive Norton, an American hybrid first introduced in 1835.

Take Rt 29 to Ruckersville, then Rt 33 East. In Barboursville turn right onto Rt. 20. Go 2 miles and turn right onto 641.

Horton Vineyards, located in Orange County, is one of the most innovative wineries in the country. Horton has the largest portfolio of wines in the state, with 40 different wines in their line-up. The winery specializes in Norton and Viognier grapes, and serves as a test bed for some exotic varietals, including Albarino, Tempranillo, Marsanne, Mourvedre, Petit Verdot and Syrah grapes from which they produce some very interesting varietal wines, blends, fruit wines, sparkling wines and even ports.

Take Rt. 29 to Ruckersville; then Rt. 33 east; winery is 8 miles on the left. From Richmond take I-64 west to Rt. 15 north to Gordonsville circle; cross circle and get on Rt. 33 west; winery is 4 miles on right.

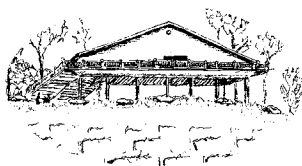


Keswick Vineyards is a 400-acre winery built on Edgewood Estate, a property rich with history dating to 1727. The unique tasting room is reminiscent of a grand horse-country barn with stunning views. The winemaker's philosophy: "Aim for quality, not quantity, and develop the best wines possible" has garnered repeated awards for Keswick's estate wines, most notably Chardonnay, Viognier, and Heritage.

Take I-64 to exit 129 (Cismont). Turn right onto Black Cat Road, follow to stop sign. Turn right onto Rt. 22 East and continue to Rt. 231 North. Follow Rt. 231 North for 2 more miles to winery entrance on right.

STONE MOUNTAIN VINEYARDS

Taste the Altitude at 1,700 feet in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains at Stone Mountain Vineyards. The winery specializes in Italian styled wines that express the uniqueness of the rocky hillside vineyards. Stone Mountain produces award

winning Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Pinot Grigio as well as proprietary blends such as Bacon Hollow Revenuers' Select.

Take Rt. 29 to Ruckersville; then Rt. 33 to Stanardsville. Turn left onto Rt. 810, Right onto Rt. 627, Right onto Rt. 632 (Wyatt Mountain Road).
